

STUDENT WELFARE

The welfare of our students is of paramount importance and we want them to remain happy and healthy throughout their stay. As a result we are committed to providing a high standard of care and supervision of all our students. Our student welfare officer who has more than 20 years experience, management in the college, academic staff, sports coaches and activity staff all share this commitment to provide students with the best possible care and attention and to maximise their experience during their study holiday. For students travelling as individuals or in small groups there is a nominated SLS staff member to act as leader during their stay.

The college is located a short distance from the centre of the Stillorgan area which has numerous medical clinics, doctors and dentist surgeries. Students are reminded to bring their European Health Insurance card as well as any private health and travel insurance. Any visits to doctors, dentists or hospitals not covered under the European Health Insurance card must be paid for by the student. Students will be accompanied by either their group leader or a member of SLS staff.

Students with known medical conditions or allergies should provide this information with their booking application. Any such information will naturally be treated in the strictest confidence.

CLASSES & CLASSROOMS

Classes are available at all levels from Elementary (A1) to Advanced (C1). Classes have a maximum of 15 students per class. Two teachers, covering different prearranged areas of the syllabus, work alternately with each class. This provides variety for the students and allows them to benefit from the different personalities and teaching styles.

All classrooms are modern and spacious. All textbooks and other learning materials are available to students. At the end of the course students receive a certificate of attendance and completion.

ACTIVITIES & EXCURSIONS

Shandon Language Solutions offers a very comprehensive programme of cultural, sports and evening activities. Sports and cultural activities, which take place in the afternoons, are an important part of the course and have a role in improving language skills. Sports comprise of football, rugby, basketball, tennis, rounders, volleyball and table tennis. Arts and crafts are also available along with dance, yoga and drama. One to two afternoons each week there are cultural trips to Dublin by public transport. Each Saturday a full day excursion to places of interest outside of Dublin by private coach is organised.

Evening activities are held three days per week and are available for all students on any SLS course. Activities include discos, Irish nights, karaoke, quiz night, sports & games competitions and movie nights. Evening activities normally take place from 20:00 to 22:00.

The activities programme provides students with an opportunity to absorb some of Ireland's rich heritage in a fun and relaxed way while also allowing students from different nationalities the opportunity to get to know each other outside the classroom

LOCATION

Shandon Language Solutions (SLS) operates out of Oatlands College, which is located in Mount Merrion, South County Dublin

The college is located beside Stillorgan and lies on a large private campus with state of the art sporting facilities completed at the end of 2011. The college is situated close to a number of major bus routes making it easily accessible from Dublin City Centre or surrounding suburbs. Bus from the college into the City takes approximately 20 minutes. Bus numbers 46A, 7 and 145 stop outside the school gates.

ABOUT THE COLLEGE

The college has fully equipped classrooms with modern teaching facilities, a school hall equipped for concerts and productions, school canteen, library, an art room, music room and computer room. The College has recently undergone extensive building of a new state of the art sports hall which caters for basketball, volleyball and indoor soccer. Other sports facilities include a full size grass football pitch, a second sports hall catering for indoor sports, changing facilities and showers and additional green space.

ACCOMMODATION

Students attending Oatlands College stay with host families which are carefully selected and inspected regularly by our accommodation officer. Regular contact is maintained with each host family during the student's stay. The host families are conveniently located to the college by bus and have many years' experience looking after students.

Accommodation is arranged on a full board basis with packed lunch Monday to Saturday. Students normally share a room with a student of a similar age but of different nationality. Unless specifically requested there is only one student of any particular nationality in each family.
